Housing First Program

Support for individuals & families who are experiencing homelessness using the Housing First philosophy.

To access Housing First, an intake needs to be completed with *Housing Access* to determine if you are eligible for supports. Housing First is unable to take their own direct referrals.

The Housing First Program is funded through the Province of Alberta, Outreach Services Supports Initiative (OSSI). OSSI funding is managed by the City of Grande Prairie.

*There is no fee charged for this service.

Housing Access Services (HAS)

Provide information & intake assessments for people in Grande Prairie who are experiencing homelessness.

The Housing Access Service is funded through the Province of Alberta, Outreach Services Supports Initiative (OSSI). OSSI funding is managed by the City of Grande Prairie.

Just Enough Support Program (JESP)

This program focuses on helping individuals achieve their goals and encourages them to become as independent as possible. Centerpoint's vision for JESP is to promote independence and assist adults with disabilities in becoming included and active participants in the community.

To access the Just Enough Supports Program you must be PDD (Person with Developmental Disability).

The JESP is unable to take their own direct referrals.
